



WINTER ACTIVITIES PERMITTED ON THE GOLF COURSE

The Big Horn Board of Directors are pleased to see the many residents of Sun Rivers enjoying recreational activities on the course as we get our exercise during COVID-19. Thanks to all that have been enjoying the activities while staying on the cart paths where possible and picking up after your pets.

Big Horn has recently been notified by our insurance company to advise the community of additional information required to reduce our liability risk.

In addition to our previous newsletter which outlined our winter use policy we are required to post additional signage at various access points on the golf course stating:

Winter access on the golf course is at user risk and only walking, snowshoeing and cross country skiing is permitted. Sledding and tobogganing are not allowed.

Please observe the following **Winter Rules** while enjoying the use of the golf course:

- no walking on grass if frost is present
- snowshoeing & cross country skiing needs enough snow (**10+ cm**) on the course so as not to damage the course. Please wait until there is enough snow on the course.
- **sledding and toboggan activities are NOT permitted**
- please travel on the outside of the fairways using the existing cart paths where possible.
- no walking on greens or tee boxes as they are particularly easy to damage.
- all dogs must be on a leash and owners must pick up after them
- no fires or fireworks on the golf course

Thank you all for respecting the policies so we can all get out and enjoy the course.
